

Dear Parents,

Welcome to the 2018 season of Farmington Summer Ball! I hope everyone is excited and ready to have another fun and successful season. It is the league's goal to teach your child the fundamentals of the sport, and life skills that they will use in their future endeavors.

As many of you may know Farmington is part of the Washington County Civic League (WCCL). If you child is 7 years old or older they will be traveling to Prairie Grove, Lincoln, Greenland, West Fork and possibly Huntsville and Westville, OK to play games. They of course will play multiple home games in Farmington. The younger age groups will be playing the earlier games, 5:30 6:30, the older the team the later the game. Please remember unless your child's team is playing the first game of the night their game will probably start a few minutes late. We as coordinators try our hardest to get the games going as close to on time as possible, but most of the time we are not able to do that. Game will be played on Monday, Tuesday, Thursdays and Fridays, with make-up games possibly being played on Wednesdays and Sunday afternoons. Your child's team will usually play 2 nights a week or at least 2 games. If we have a lot of rain or bad weather that number could be more or less. We try our best to get all the games rescheduled to fit every team's schedule, but sometimes it won't be the best situation.

WCCL follows USSSA rules. If you would like to look at and/or print off a rule book you can go to USSA.com. We do however have some modified rules for each age group that are posted under the documents tab on the WCCL website, wccl.org. If we do not have a modified rule posted we will then follow USSSA. WCCL.org will also be used to check game schedules and rainout information. Once schedules are up please DO NOT print the schedule out, because it can change daily. I would recommend checking this website daily during the season. You will also be able to get information from our Facebook Page, Farmington Sports Complex. In the event of inclement weather I will contact the coaches and updated the Facebook page and the WCCL website. (if you play in a different town please check WCCL.org)

T-BALL Parents:

You will be able to find information about games and rainouts on our Facebook page. Since our T-Ball program is not a part of WCCL we will play all of our games in Farmington at the Sports Complex. Games will be on Monday and/or possibly Tuesday nights. Games will begin at 5:30 and/or 6:30. Games will not go longer than 60 minutes. We will not keep score in these games but will keep up with outs. At this age we want to develop their skills for when they moved up to 8u.

- Pants/Shorts (I would wait until after your first team practice) ***City will provide shirt***

- Bat (Optional)

8u-14u Parents:

If you are new to the program or are wanting to be placed on a new team, we will be having our draft the 1st week of March. This draft is just for the coaches. After the draft has taken place then your coach will contact you by either phone or email.

-Cleats (Boys 12u and younger rubber cleats, Girls 12u and younger rubber cleats.)

-Helmet (Girl's helmets must have a facemask)

-Bat (optional but must have USSSA thumbprint stamp)
