

Recommendation

Requesting to replace/build new batting cages on existing pad at sports complex.

Background

We lost our batting cage we had up this last spring due to strong winds.

Discussion

I have spoken with a couple different groups about getting new batting cages at the ballpark. I spoke with a few fencing companies and then found Chad Barber with American Sports Facilities, he specializes in building cages. He will fabricate a frame that will withstand the weather and put down turf on the concrete pad to protect the batters and pitchers in the cages. We will have 2 full cages versus the 1 we had previously.

Budget Impact

The total cost of this project will be \$ 13,868.03.
